



**2009 NCYC Youth Animator
Formation Program
July 24-26, 2009
Kansas City**



Purpose

The Youth Animators Formation Program is designed to form young people to take lead roles in general session programming at the 2009 National Catholic Youth Conference, especially as prayer leaders. The hope is that young people may also apply the skills and knowledge gained as Youth Animators to roles in their parishes and schools.

Eligibility

The Youth Animator Formation Program is open to young people who meet the following requirements:

- Must be entering/in high school in fall 2009
- Must be planning to attend the 2009 National Catholic Youth Conference in Kansas City
- Must be able to participate in the Youth Animator Formation Program in Kansas City
- Open to participating in selected areas of NCYC ministry: song, dance/movement, and oral proclamations

Requirements

- Attendance and participation in all sessions during the formation program. (Program begins at noon on Friday, July 24, and concludes at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 26.)
- Presence in Kansas City at the Sprint Center by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 18, 2009 for the beginning of rehearsals and sound checks through 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 21, 2009. (Youth must be chaperoned in accordance with their diocesan youth protection policies.)
- Participation in all assignments given during the formation program.

Applicants do NOT need to be “professionals” or to have had any previous training in the areas in which they wish to primarily participate. All that is required is a commitment to do their best and follow the instructions of the formation team. All youth selected to be animators will be asked to sing and perform basic dance steps whether or not it is their primary area of ministry.

Application Process and Deadline

The application includes an application form, audition video/DVD of five minutes or less, and a letter of reference from a parish or diocesan leader. Completed applications must be submitted by April 15. Applications are not considered complete unless all items are included and the application form is signed by the applicant’s parent/guardian **AND** diocesan NCYC group leader.

Selection Criteria/Process

Materials will be reviewed by the three-person NCYC Program Team, who will also act as formation team leaders. Selection will be based on the combination of application essay question responses, audition video/ DVD, and personal recommendations. Preference in selection will be given to young people from the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph and Archdiocese of Kansas City first, then Region 9 (the dioceses in the states of Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska), and then the remainder of the country. Approximately 80 young people will be accepted for the program. Young people will be informed in writing of their application status on/about June 1, 2009. If accepted, notification will include details of where the program is being held and how to pay registration fee along with required permission and release forms.

Registration Fee

The fee for the Youth Animator Formation Program is \$250 per student. The fee includes the following formation weekend items: double occupancy dorm/retreat-style housing, seven meals (starting with lunch on Friday and concluding with lunch on Sunday), assorted snacks, music, and instruction, as well as complimentary NCYC registration and six meals during NCYC (three breakfasts, two lunches, and one dinner). Animators will also receive a commemorative youth animator t-shirt. Chaperones are asked to pay \$125 to cover the cost of their meals and double occupancy housing during the formation program.

NOTE:REGISTRATION FEE WILL BE REFUNDED FOLLOWING THE 2009 NCYC PROVIDED ANIMATOR HAS PARTICIPATED AS SCHEDULED.

Additional Fees

Items not part of the registration fee include, but are not limited to: transportation to or within Kansas City for either the formation program or NCYC, hotel accommodations for NCYC (Wednesday to Sunday), meals not listed as included, and chaperone expenses for NCYC.

Sponsors

The National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry and the Office of Youth Ministry of the Archdiocese of Kansas City are the sponsors of the 2009 NCYC Youth Animators Formation Program with support from the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
