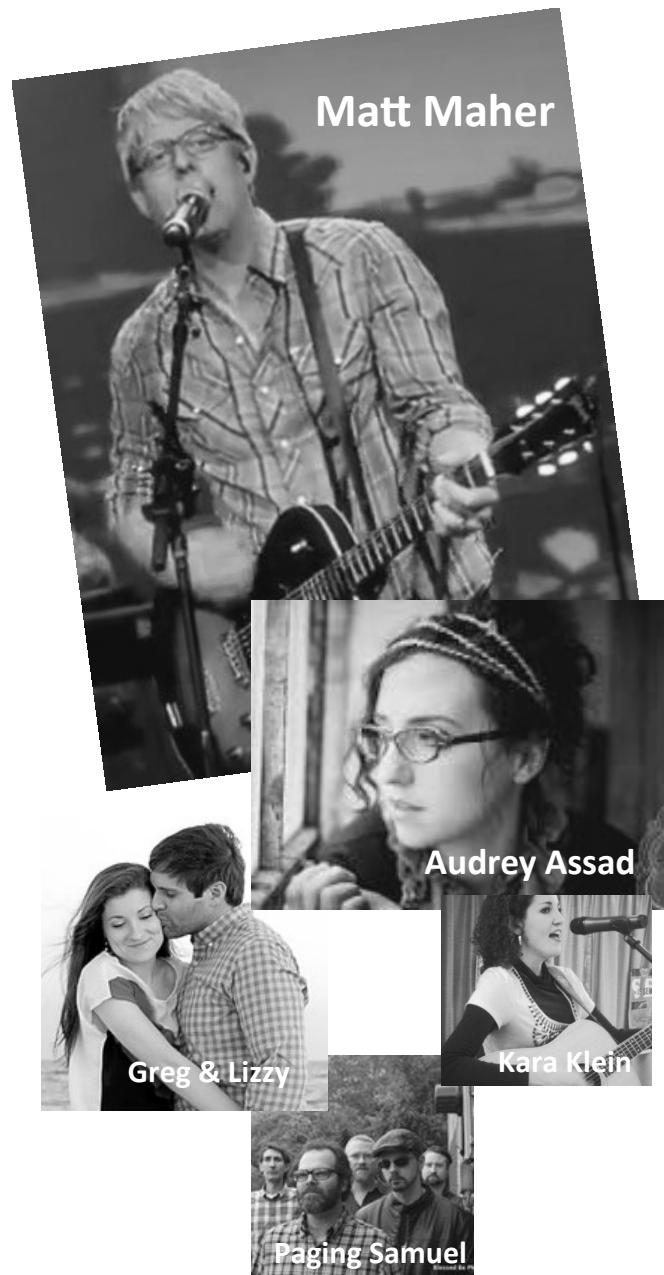
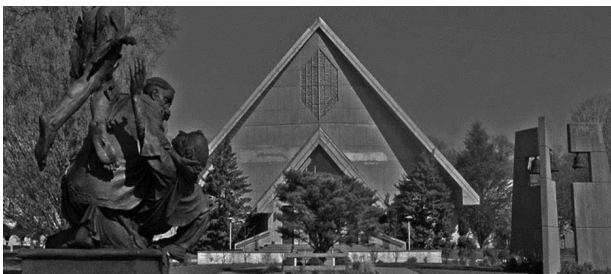
Philadelphia's First Catholic Christian Rock Festival
