In addition, the 14th Annual CYM Pilgrimage is Saturday, March 23, 2024.

YLT members will engage in team building exercises, engage in leadership training, design and implement faith-sharing activities, and assist with the annual CYM Pilgrimage, Recognition Dinner, and Diocesan youth events. Any young person in the age group can sign up, but must be approved by their pastor or principal. **Returning YLT members must still submit a new registration.** The cost is \$50 per student leader, ordinarily paid for by the parish or Catholic school that the student represents.

The deadline for the Youth Leadership Team application and all appropriate forms is Sunday, September 17, 2023!
