## 10 Ways to Encourage Good Sportsmanship



- 1. Always be an example of good sportsmanship for your players
- 2. Encourage players to use appropriate language to express themselves
- 3. Use positive reinforcement to encourage fair play
- 4. Never humiliate a player or allow humiliation towards players by others
- 5. Every member of the team is important, give them all a chance to play
- Encourage the spectators to cheer appropriately and positively for all the players in the game
- The opposing team is not the enemy. Neither are the officials. Treat both with respect
- 8. Remember that every player is unique, with different gifts to offer
- 9. Instruct players so that they know the consequences of their actions
- 10. Begin each game in prayer, end each game with a sportsmanship line and, if possible, a group prayer
