PACKING LIST

Please note there is a dress code (moderate dress with no short shorts, tank tops, loose fitting pants)

- Work Clothes (long pants and t-shirts (*SHORTS are NOT PERMITTED to be worn at worksite*))
- Work gloves
- Casual/Comfortable Clothes (for evening activities)
- Sweatshirt/long sleeve t-shirt/light jacket (evenings may be cool)
- Pajamas
- Under garments and TWO pairs of socks PER day
- Sturdy sneakers/ work boots for work site (*MUST have closed toes!*)
- Showering shoes (flip flops)
- Rain gear (we will work even in the rain)
- Small Backpack (to carry personal items to and from worksite)
- Swimsuit (must be modest) and Beach Towel
- Bath towel and wash cloth
- Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, etc.)
- Medication: *Over-the-counter and prescription medication must be in original containers and placed in a labeled, ziploc plastic bag. Please only send amount needed for the week. All medications will be administered by our staff.*
- Pillow, Sleeping bag or TWIN size air mattress or camping pad
- Sun Protection (sunscreen, lip balm, hat, sunglasses)
- Insect repellent
- Flash light w/batteries
- Bible (St. Mary's Press Catholic Youth Bible is highly recommended!)
- Personal journal, pens and markers
- Frisbees/football/basketball
- Positive attitude, flexibility, willingness to serve God
- Tools
 - Hammer
 - Shovel
 - Yard Rake

In addition to this list, the following items will be turned in by participants upon arrival:

- BOYS are to bring one two liter bottle of soda for use by the group at mealtimes
- GIRLS are to bring a large bag of chips or cookies for use by the group at snack times

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME:

- Your brand new \$100 pair of jeans. You will be getting dirty! Bring clothes that you don't mind working in and possibly ruining.
- A water bottle - each participant will be given a 20 oz. souvenir bottle.
- Your curling iron/straightening iron/host of primping aides and products. You will be working too hard all day to waste your time/makeup/hair gel on primping! Pitcher & Basin is a workcamp, not a dating service.
